

Subject Childhood trauma-informed policy and practices task force

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Overview

This bill would require the establishment of a task force to create childhood trauma-informed policies and practices, reduce children's exposure to adverse childhood experiences (ACEs), and address racial and ethnic disparities related to family health and well-being.

1	<p>Task force on childhood trauma-informed policy and practices. Proposes coding for § 256E.245.</p> <p>Subd. 1. Establishment. Requires the commissioner of human services to establish and appoint a task force on trauma-informed policy and practices, and reduce children's exposure to ACEs. Lists the members of the task force.</p> <p>Subd. 2. Staff. Requires the commissioner of human services to provide meeting space, support staff, and administrative services.</p> <p>Subd. 3. Duties. Requires the task force to: (1) engage the human services, education, public health, and justice systems to create trauma-informed policy and practices, prevent and reduce ACEs, and support family health and well-being; and (2) identify social determinants of family health and well-being, and recommend solutions to eliminate racial and ethnic disparities in Minnesota.</p> <p>Subd. 4. Report. Requires the task force to submit a report on its results and policy recommendations to the relevant legislative committees, by January 15 of each year.</p> <p>Subd. 5. Expiration. Specifies that the task force expires June 30, 2025.</p> <p>Makes this section effective the day following final enactment.</p>



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
