## Overview

The Sanneh Foundation programs provide all-day, in-school, and after-school academic and behavioral interventions for low-performing and chronically absent students focusing on underserved students of color and students from low-income families. Program goals include decreasing school absenteeism, encouraging school engagement, improving student grades, and increasing graduation rates.

The 2016 Legislature appropriated \$1.5 million for this program and the 2017 Legislature appropriated \$1 million for expansion of the program.

H.F. 1344 appropriates \$2 million in fiscal year 2021 to the Sanneh Foundation for additional programming and makes the funding part of the base budget for future years.
