



Subject Sunday sales—hours of sale

Overview

Liquor may be not be sold at the times in which liquor sales are prohibited by state law. Current law prohibits Sunday sales of liquor except between the hours of 11 a.m. and 6 p.m. and prohibits sales of liquor on Monday through Saturday except between the hours of 8 a.m. and 10 p.m. No sales are allowed on Thanksgiving Day or Christmas Day, or after 8 p.m. on Christmas Eve.

If Christmas Eve falls on a Sunday, sales may not therefore be made before 11 a.m. or after 6 p.m. under current law. In addition, if New Year's Eve falls on a Sunday, sales before and after these times are likewise prohibited.

H.F. 1462 would modify the Sunday sales law to allow sales between 10 a.m. and 5 p.m.In addition, this bill would allow sales of liquor between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. onChristmas Eve, if that day falls on a Sunday. Lastly, if New Year's Eve falls on a Sunday,H.F. 1462 would allow sales between 10 a.m. and 10 p.m.

Summary

Section Description

1 Intoxicating liquor; off-sale.

Amends the hours of sale provisions to allow Sunday sales of liquor between the hours of 10 a.m. and 5 p.m. and to allow expanded Sunday sales of liquor on Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve.
