

**Subject** Youth skills training program

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## Overview

Modifies the youth skills training program and limits grants to \$100,000 each. Appropriates \$1,500,000 a year in ongoing funding from the workforce development fund for the youth skills training program.

1	<p><b>Duties.</b></p> <p>Adds that the youth skills training programs the commissioner of labor and industry approves must also train student learners for careers in high-growth, high-demand occupations.</p>
2	<p><b>Grant awards.</b></p> <p>Limits grant awards to local partnerships for youth skills training programs that train student learners for careers in high-growth, high-demand occupations to \$100,000 per grant.</p>
3	<p><b>Appropriation; youth skills training program.</b></p> <p>Appropriates \$1,500,000 in fiscal year 2020 and \$1,500,000 in fiscal year 2021 from the workforce development fund for the youth skills training program.</p> <p>When the youth skills training program was created in the 2017 Jobs Omnibus law, it was also appropriated \$200,000 in fiscal year 2018 to develop training competencies for the new program and \$500,000 in fiscal year 2019 for grants and administration of the grant program.</p>
