Overview

This bill modifies the Pupil Fair Dismissal Act by prohibiting a school district from dismissing a child participating or enrolled in a prekindergarten program. Under the Pupil Fair Dismissal Act, a “dismissal” means the denial of the current educational program to any pupil, including exclusion, expulsion, and suspension. It does not include removal from class. The Pupil Fair Dismissal Act applies to charter schools, as well as school districts. This bill would take effect beginning in the 2019-2020 school year.
