Overview

Child care licensing agencies (either the county licenser or the Department of Human Services licensing staff) are required to offer child care license holders an “exit interview” to discuss licensing violations observed during a licensing inspection, and offer technical assistance for compliance. This bill amends section 245A.04, subdivision 4 by clarifying that the Commissioner of Human Services may issue a correction order or negative action to a child care license holder for violations of law or rule, if the license holder chooses not to participate in an exit interview.
