

**Subject** Special education

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## Overview

Districts may provide prevention services to students who do not, at that time, qualify for special education instruction but need additional academic or behavioral support to succeed in the general education environment. Districts must apply to the Department of Education to receive Alternative Delivery of Specialized Instructional Services (ADSIS) funding for these programs. Under current law, a student with an individualized education program cannot receive ADSIS services in addition to special education services.

This bill would allow a student who receives special education services to participate in an ADSIS program as long as the program is in a service area that is not included in the student's individualized education program.
