Overview

Current law requires Minnesota postsecondary institutions to establish written policies on sexual harassment and sexual violence. *See* Minn. Stat. § 135A.15. This bill would require those policies to include an affirmative consent standard, as defined in the bill. The bill also changes current law requiring student sexual assault training to incorporate this affirmative consent standard.
