Overview

This bill appropriates \$16,000,000 each fiscal year from the general fund to the commissioner of health for distribution as local public health grants to community health boards. Community health boards use local public health grants to address local public health priorities and areas of public health responsibility, identified through the community health assessment and community health improvement planning process. A community health board is the governing body for local public health activities, and it may be comprised of a single county, a single city, or multiple contiguous counties. A community health board that receives a local public health grant must provide at least a 75% local match for the state funds received.

Description Appropriations; local public health grants. Appropriates \$16,000,000 in fiscal year 2020 and \$16,000,000 in fiscal year 2021 from the general fund to the commissioner of health for local public health grants.
