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Overview

Extends to December 31, 2024, the law that authorizes Hennepin County to use "job order contracting" for projects estimated to cost up to \$250,000. Under current law, the authority expires at the end of this year.

Job order contracting was originally enacted in 2016 and means "a project delivery method that requests a limited number of bids from a list of qualified contractors, selected from a registry of qualified contractors who have been prescreened and who have entered into master contracts with the county." A project means construction, alteration, maintenance, repair, or expansion of a building, structure, road, or other capital improvement.

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
