Overview

This bill provides that individuals and entities who sell caskets or urns, and individuals not licensed under chapter 149A who make caskets or urns for personal use, are not governed by chapter 149A. Chapter 149A governs the practice of mortuary science and disposition of dead human bodies and establishes licensure requirements for the practice of mortuary science, operating funeral establishments, operating crematories, and operating alkaline hydrolysis facilities.

Amends § 149A.01, subd. 3. Provides that chapter 149A does not apply to:

- individuals or entities who sell caskets or urns; or
- individuals not licensed under chapter 149A who make caskets or urns for personal use.
