

Subject Continuation of MinnesotaCare Provider Tax

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Overview

This bill repeals a provision that sunsets the MinnesotaCare provider tax, effective for gross revenues received after December 31, 2019. The MinnesotaCare provider tax is an assessment of two percent of gross revenues for patient services received by specified health care providers (various exemptions apply). Money from the provider tax is deposited in the Health Care Access Fund.

Summary

Section	Description
1	Contingent reduction in tax. Amends § 295.52, subd. 8. Makes a conforming change related to the continuation of the MinnesotaCare provider tax. Provides an effective date of the day following final enactment.
2	Repealer. Repeals Laws 2011, First Special Session chapter 9, article 6, section 97, subdivision 6, effective the day following final enactment. This provision repeals the MinnesotaCare provider tax, effective for gross revenues received after December 31, 2019.
