Summary

This bill requires law enforcement agencies to provide victims of certain crimes who are foreign nationals a certificate identifying them as a crime victim. The victim can show this certificate to federal immigration authorities to support their request to remain in the United States under a U-visa. A U-visa is intended to protect crime victims and to ensure that foreign national crime victims are available to assist in the prosecution of those accused of the crimes.
