Overview

Opinions of the Minnesota Court of Appeals that are identified as “published” create precedent that is binding on the district courts. Unpublished opinions are currently available in a written format, but may not be cited as precedent in cases involving different parties, facts, or both. Current law restricts the cases that the court of appeals may identify as being published.
