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Overview

H.F. 3054 requires utilities to report to customers annually on the relative proportion of each fuel source the utility used to generate electricity during the previous year, and the corresponding amounts of specific air pollutants and, if applicable, nuclear waste, resulting from that generation.

Summary

Section Description

1 [216B.1697] Electric utility reports to customers; generation sources and environmental impacts.

Requires the Public Utilities Commission to develop a uniform reporting format allowing all utilities to report annually to customers:

- the proportion of different fuel sources used to generate the utility's electricity supplies;
- the number of pounds of carbon dioxide, sulfur dioxide, and nitrogen oxides released as a result of the generation of the utility's electricity supplies, expressed on a per megawatt-hour basis; and
- the amount of nuclear waste generated per megawatt-hour for electricity generated from nuclear fuel.

This information must be posted on a utility's website and forwarded to the commission and posted on the commission's website.

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
