Subject Consumer-Directed Community Supports Codification

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Summary

This bill codifies uncodified session laws related to the consumer-directed community supports (CDCS) option under the Medicaid home and community-based waivers.

The CDCS option allows individuals more flexibility and responsibility in directing their services and supports.

The revisor of statutes was directed to codify these laws in Laws 2019, First Special Session ch. 9, art. 5, § 93. Over the years, several uncodified session laws related to CDCS were enacted and amended. These laws were difficult to find because they were not all in one place. In addition, these laws were meant to be permanent. Codifying these laws puts them together in Minnesota Statutes along with the rest of the permanent laws related to Medicaid.

Article 1 of the bill codifies the uncodified session laws related to CDCS in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 256B and repeals the session laws. Article 2 of the bill provides for uniform terminology and adds cross-references.
