1	<b>Requirements for instructors [§120A.22, subd. 10]</b> Eliminates, under the compulsory instruction section, the option of completing a “teacher competency examination” to fulfil the minimum requirements to provide instruction to a child. No such relevant examination currently exists in Minnesota.
2	<b>Additional duties [§124D.141, subd. 2]</b> Eliminates outdated or now unnecessary language.
3	<b>Early childhood program eligibility [§124D.165, subd. 4]</b> Eliminates obsolete language.
4	<b>Revenue reserved [§124D.862, subd. 7]</b> Updates an incorrect reference in achievement and integration aid section.
5	<b>Services to people with visual and physical disabilities [§134.31, subd. 4a]</b> Updates references to conform with federal terminology changes.
6	<b>Limitations of order effective January 1, 2015, and later [§609A.03, subd. 7a]</b> Removes MDE from the list of agencies that receive notifications of criminal expungements, which is obsolete after the creation of PELSB.
7	<b>Revisor instruction.</b> Reorganizes subsections of Minnesota Statutes, section 120B.30, pertaining to statewide testing and reporting, into new subdivisions and sections. The changes in
