Overview

This bill modifies a special license plate for Purple Heart medal recipients, so that:

- there is no fee imposed for the plate, including for annual validation stickers and for plate transfers;
- the plate can be personalized;
- the applicant does not have to have been honorably discharged (and active service members continue to be eligible); and
- the plate is no longer offered for noncommercial one-ton pickup trucks.

It also makes technical and conforming changes to codify the special plate in a new section of statutes. The changes are effective August 1, 2020.

Summary

Section Description

1 Personalized plates; rules.

Allows personalization of Purple Heart special license plates. Establishes that there is no fee for plate replacement of the plates.

2 Design.

Eliminates Purple Heart plate design and eligibility requirements from a section on various veterans plates, which is substantially reproduced in section 3.

3 [168.1245] Special plates for Purple Heart recipients.

Creates a separate section authorizing Purple Heart special license plates. Provides for plate eligibility, design, application, and issuance as well as transfers free of charge.

Subd. 1. Issuance and design. Sets qualification requirements to obtain the plate and identifies the plate design.

Section Description

Subd. 2. Application. Limits application for plates to the times of initial registration or renewal. Requires distribution of information on proof of eligibility requirements.

Subd. 3. No fee. Provides the plates and annual validation stickers free of charge, including for plate replacement.

Subd. 4. Transfer. Allows the plates to be transferred to another personal vehicle that is registered to the same person, on notice to the Department of Public Safety.

4 Discontinuance of plate.

Makes a conforming change.
