

Subject Medical recuperative health homes

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Summary

This bill expands medical assistance coverage of health home services to cover medical recuperative health home services, and makes conforming changes in the existing health homes statute, section 256B.0757. Individuals are eligible for medical recuperative health home services if they are diagnosed with a chronic condition, as defined in federal law, and if they lack a permanent place of residence at the time of referral from an emergency department or hospital. The bill makes the expansion of eligible individuals effective upon federal approval.
