Summary

H.F. 3573 would allow a city to issue an on-sale wine or malt liquor license to the owner of a summer collegiate league baseball team (or a person holding a concessions contract with the owner) for the sale of wine and beer at any event taking place at a ballpark or stadium. Current law limits alcohol service under these licenses to sales during baseball games.
