

Subject Temporary vehicle permits

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Overview

This bill modifies requirements for temporary motor vehicle permits, including to change the location where the permit must be displayed. The changes are effective in conjunction with implementation of the replacement motor vehicle title and registration information technology system.

Summary

Section	Description
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| 1 | Display of temporary permit.
Modifies the location to display a temporary permit issued in conjunction with expired registration, to be where a license plate is normally displayed instead of in the rear window. Requires the permit to be plainly visible. |
| 2 | 31-day temporary vehicle permit.
Modifies the location to display a 31-day temporary permit (issued to nonresidents for transporting the vehicle out of state), to be affixed to the rear of the vehicle instead of in the rear window. Removes a requirement that dealers provide information on permit issuances to the Department of Public Safety. |
| 3 | 21-day temporary vehicle permit.
Modifies the location to display a 21-day temporary permit (issued for vehicle purchases), to be where a license plate is normally displayed instead of in the rear window. Requires the permit to be plainly visible. Eliminates a dealer recordkeeping requirement. |
| 4 | Effective date.
Makes the bill effective the earlier of (1) January 1, 2021, or (2) when the replacement vehicle title and registration information technology system is first deployed. |



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
