## **Summary**

Appropriates \$600,000 in fiscal year 2021 from the general fund for a grant to the Neighborhood Development Center for small business incubator programs, both new and existing. This appropriation is a onetime addition to the previous appropriation in the 2019 Jobs omnibus law of \$650,000 each year from the workforce development fund for small business programs.

The Neighborhood Development Center previously also received: \$750,000 each year in the 2017 Jobs omnibus law for small business programs, including the development of new business incubators; and \$1,500,000 in fiscal year 2017 under the 2016 supplemental omnibus law, for both small business development programs and small business incubators.
