Overview

H.F. 204 eliminates the eight-year limit on the spousal benefit for the disabled veterans' homestead exclusion. Under current law, the spouse of an eligible veteran who has died can continue to receive the exclusion for eight additional years, or until they remarry or sell the property. H.F. 204 eliminates the eight-year limit, however, if the spouse remarries or sells the property, they are no longer eligible for the exclusion.
