## Section Description

## 1 Radon testing.

**Subd. 1. Plan.** Requires the commissioners of health and education to develop a plan to require school districts to test for radon. Testing requirements apply to the Minnesota State Academies and the Perpich Center for Arts Education.

**Subd. 2. Radon testing.** Requires a school district to include radon testing as part of its ten-year facility plan. Requires all districts to conduct the test according to the testing plan developed by the commissioners of health and education.

**Subd. 3. Reporting.** Requires a school district to report its results to the Department of Education. Classifies radon testing results as public data.
