Overview

This bill would allow an off-highway vehicle (OHV) to access certain campground facilities at Lake Vermilion-Soudan Underground Mine State Park

Summary

Section

1 Lake-Vermilion-Soudan Underground Mine State Park; secondary unit designation.

Requires the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) to designate a portion of Lake Vermilion-Soudan Underground Mine State Park south of State Highway 169 as a secondary unit within the park and manage it as a state recreation area. Requires the DNR to allow the use of off-highway vehicles (all-terrain vehicles, off-road motorcycles, and off-road vehicles) on designated trails and roads that provide access to overnight facilities within the secondary unit.
