Overview

This bill would allow a person entering a fish or wildlife stamp design contest sponsored by the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) to use nonphotographic digital media.

The DNR holds a number of stamp design contests (trout and salmon, waterfowl, pheasant, walleye and turkey). Under existing rule, a person cannot enter a design created by a photographic, digital or electronic imagery process.

1	<p>Stamp design; rule amendment.</p> <p>Requires the commissioner of natural resources to amend DNR rules to allow stamp design contest entries to be created using nonphotographic digital media and require a person entering a stamp design contest to list all media used in creating the entry. Allows the commissioner to use the good cause exemption from the state's rulemaking procedure to amend the rules.</p>
