Delete everything amendment (A19-0085)

Subject Coverage of insulin, equipment, and supplies

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Overview

This bill requires health carriers to disclose coverage of brands of insulin, equipment, and supplies and prohibits them from removing coverage of a brand of insulin, equipment, and supplies during an enrollee's contract year.

Summary

Section Description

1 Coverage change.

- (a) Requires health carriers to disclose to enrollees or prospective enrollees the brands of insulin, equipment, and supplies covered, upon request of the enrollee.
- (b) Prohibits health carriers from removing coverage for a brand of insulin, equipment, and supplies during an enrollee's contract year. This does not apply if the brand is unsafe or has been withdrawn from the market by the manufacturer.
- (c) Defines "enrollee's contract year" as the 12-month term that benefits are provided for under a health plan.

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
