Overview

This bill makes three onetime appropriations in fiscal year 2020 of \$150,000 each to the Southern Minnesota Initiative Foundation, the Southwest Initiative Foundation, and the Neighborhood Development Center. The grants to the initiative foundations are for minority entrepreneur training and development and the grant to the Neighborhood Development Center is for outreach and training activities in greater Minnesota.

The 2017 Jobs Omnibus law made a onetime appropriation to the Neighborhood Development Center of \$750,000 each year in fiscal years 2018 and 2019 for services that included outreach and training in greater Minnesota, among other purposes.
