

Subject Licensed food handlers fee—liquor stores

Overview

This bill would require the Minnesota Department of Agriculture to exclude a liquor store's gross sales of off-sale alcoholic beverages when determining the appropriate food handler license fee. According to a tiered fee schedule in Minnesota Statutes, section 28A.08, liquor stores and other food handlers with greater gross sales of eligible products are required to pay a higher license fee.

Liquor stores are currently exempt from the fee if, in addition to liquor, they only sell prepackaged ice, bottled or canned soft drinks, and prepackaged candy.
