Overview

The 2017 Legislature required the Commissioner of Human Services to implement a program to use volume purchasing for incontinence products and related supplies. This bill repeals this requirement.

Section	Description
1	Repealer. Repeals section 256B.0625, subdivision 31c (directive to the commissioner of human services to implement a preferred incontinence product program, using volume purchasing).

Provides that the section is effective the day following final enactment.
