Overview

The 2017 Legislature required the Commissioner of Human Services to implement a program to use volume purchasing for incontinence products and related supplies. This bill repeals this requirement, and also prohibits the commissioner from using volume purchasing and competitive bidding for incontinence products.

1	Competitive bidding. Amends § 256B.04, subd. 14.
	Prohibits the commissioner of human services from using volume purchase through competitive bidding and negotiation for incontinence products and related supplies.
	Provides that the section is effective the day following final enactment.
2	Repealer.
	Repeals section 256B.0625, subdivision 31c (directive to the commissioner of human services to implement a preferred incontinence product program, using volume purchasing).
	Provides that the section is effective the day following final enactment.
