Overview

This bill amends the current standard for consumer services waivers and releases of liability by providing that releases from liability for ordinary negligence are also void and unenforceable.

Summary

Section	Description
1	Certain agreements are void and unenforceable.
	Provides that when provisions of a signed waiver by a consumer release a company from liability for actions that result in injury or death, those provisions that release the company from liability for conduct that is ordinary negligence or greater than ordinary negligence are unenforceable. This section would be effective on August 1, 2019, and

would apply to contracts or waivers signed on or after that date.
