Overview

This bill requires providers to establish a provider-patient relationship through an examination, for the purposes of prescribing ophthalmic goods, and outlines requirements for the required examination.

1 Provider-patient relationship required.

Description

Amends § 145.713 by adding subd. 4.

Paragraph (a) defines the following terms, for purposes of this subdivision:

- "Contact lens"
- "Ophthalmic prescription"
- "Provider"

Paragraph (b) requires a provider (an optometrist or physician) to establish a providerpatient relationship through an examination, in order to prescribe ophthalmic goods to a patient.

Paragraph (c) specifies that an examination for the purposes of paragraph (b) must be:

- 1) in person;
- 2) through face-to-face interactive communication; or
- 3) through store-and-forward technologies, under specified conditions.

Paragraph (d) specifies that this subdivision does not apply to the sale of over-thecounter reader eyeglasses.

Makes this section effective July 1, 2019, for prescriptions written on or after that date.



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
