Subject Deer Hunting License Fee Revenues

Overview

This bill would increase the amount of money from the sale of resident and nonresident adult deer hunting licenses that is deposited in the deer management account from \$2 to \$16. It would also remove the statutory appropriation from the account. The bill is effective retroactively to March 1, 2018, which is the date the recent deer license fee increases became effective.

Under current law, \$2 from all deer licenses is deposited in the account and the account is statutorily appropriated to the commissioner to be used for deer habitat improvement and deer management programs.

Summary

Deer, bear, and lifetime licenses. Increases, from \$2 to \$16, the amount from each resident and nonresident adult deer license sold that is credited to the deer management account. Removes the statutory appropriation of the account. Provides a retroactive effective date of March 1, 2018.
