Overview

The K-12 finance budget contains a line item appropriation for grants to certain children's museums. The fiscal year 2018 and fiscal year 2019 appropriations were for \$319,000 each year for the Minnesota Children's Museum, including \$50,000 each year for the Minnesota Children's Museum, Rochester; \$50,000 each year for the Duluth Children's Museum; \$41,000 each year for the Minnesota Academy of Science; and \$50,000 each year for the Headwaters Science Museum. Some museum projects receive funding from Legacy funds. The base budget for grants to support children's museums is \$460,000 each year.

This bill appropriates \$31,000 in fiscal year 2020 and in fiscal year 2021 for a grant to the Children's Discovery Museum in Grand Rapids.
