

Subject Dental Administrator

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## Overview

This bill directs the commissioner of human services to contract with up to two dental administrators to administer dental services for MA and MinnesotaCare recipients.

1	<p><b>Contract for dental administration services.</b></p> <p>Adds § 256B.0375. (a) Directs the commissioner of human services, effective January 1, 2020, to contract with up to two dental administrators, to administer dental services for all recipients of MA and MinnesotaCare.</p> <p>(b) Requires the administrator to provide administrative services, including but not limited to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) provider recruitment, contracting, and assistance;</li><li>2) recipient outreach and assistance;</li><li>3) utilization management and medical necessity review for dental services;</li><li>4) dental claims processing;</li><li>5) coordination with other services;</li><li>6) management of fraud and abuse;</li><li>7) monitoring access to dental services;</li><li>8) performance measurement;</li><li>9) quality improvement and evaluation requirements; and</li><li>10) management of third-party liability.</li></ol> <p>(c) Sets payments to contracted dental providers at the rates established under § 256B.76 (the MA reimbursement rate).</p>



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
