Overview

This bill allows for a driver's license or Minnesota identification card holder to optionally identify up to three emergency contacts as part of the person's record. The information would be accessible by peace officers as well as emergency medical personnel in order to notify the contacts about an emergency. It is effective July 1, 2020.
