## Overview

Under current law, Minnesota State Colleges and Universities award workforce development scholarships to encourage students at two-year institutions to enroll in programs linked to the following high-demand occupations: advanced manufacturing, agriculture, health care services, and information technology. The bill would expand that list to include early childhood development and services.

A blank appropriation is included to fund the entire workforce development scholarship program.
