Summary

Section	Description
1	Crime described.
	Establishes a crime for removing or obliterating a permanent sticker invalidating a registration plate pursuant to the license plate impoundment sanction for driving while intoxicated.
2	Peace officer as agent for notice of impoundment.

Permits an officer empowered to seize license plates pursuant to DWI impoundment to affix a permanent sticker on the plate.

3 Temporary permit.

Directs officers to provide temporary vehicle permits when impounding a vehicle's license plates following a DWI offense. Establishes that the permit will be valid for 14 days if the person either fails a breath test or refuses to submit to a test. Further establishes that the permit will be valid for 45 days if the person submits to a blood or urine test.
