Summary

Section	Description
1	Reinstatement of driving privileges; notice.
	Strikes the requirement that an individual whose license was revoked for committing a driving while intoxicated offense must take an examination before reinstatement.
2	Examination required.
	Strikes the requirement that someone whose license is revoked for refusing or failing a test of the person's blood, urine, or breath related to a DWI offense must take an examination before the license can be reinstated. Provides that the examination requirement does not apply to a person whose license has been revoked following a conviction for a DWI offense.
