Overview

This bill modifies requirements relating to conciliation conferences.

Summary

Section Description

1 Alternative dispute resolution; additional requirements for prior written notice.

Requires the prior written notice to state that a parent who objects to a proposal or refusal in the notice may request a meeting of the individualized education program team.

2 Alternative dispute resolution; conciliation conference.

Requires a district to have a meeting of the individualized education program team when a parent who objects to a proposal requests the meeting. Requires a district to hold a conciliation conference within ten calendar days of when the district receives the parent's request for the conference, rather than from when the district receives the parent's objection to a proposal or refusal in the prior written notice.

3 Alternative dispute resolution; voluntary dispute resolution options.

Eliminates requirement that a district offer a parent at least one conciliation conference.
