Overview

This bill increases the MA income limit for persons who are age 65 or older, blind, or have disabilities over a five-year period, from 100 percent of the federal poverty guidelines (FPG) to 125 percent of FPG effective January 1, 2024.

- 115 percent of FPG effective January 1, 2022;
- 120 percent of FPG effective January 1, 2023; and
- 125 percent of FPG effective January 1, 2024.
