Overview

This bill appropriates a total of \$425,000 for the 2020-2021 biennium for grants to support water conservation programming in Minnesota schools.

The bill designates two grant recipients: H2O for Life, and Independent School District No. 624, White Bear Lake. The bill also includes funding for competitive grants to schools to implement a water conservation curriculum and co-develop a central platform to connect volunteers, water education professionals, curricula, and other resources to school districts across the state.
