

**Subject** Conforming recreational vehicles to motor vehicle DWI law

## Overview

In 2018, the legislature passed Little Alan's Law which generally conformed the consequences for operating an off-road vehicle while under the influence with the consequences for operating a motor vehicle while under the influence. The law expanded the prohibition on operating off-road vehicles following a conviction for a driving while intoxicated offense and eliminated the driver's license revocation exemption for off-road DWI offenses.

This bill further conforms the laws relating to off-road vehicles and motor vehicles.
