Summary

This bill would require a caution statement to be included on the label of corn and soybean seed sold in Minnesota if the seed is coated or treated with a neonicotinoid pesticide. Specifically, the label would state that planting the seed could negatively impact pollinator health and urge care when handling and planting the seed.

Neonicotinoids are a class of systemic pesticides, including such insecticides as acetamiprid, clothianidin, dinotefuran, imidacloprid, and thiamethoxam.
