

Subject Critical incident review process

Overview

This bill requires the executive director of the Peace Officer Standards and Training Board (POST) to appoint a critical incident review team to investigate police shootings and police-involved deaths. Each team will consist of at least three members and must include a peace officer (active or retired) and a member of the community where the incident occurred. The team must prepare a report containing its findings and recommendations, if any. The agency that employs the officer involved in the incident must pay the costs of the team's investigation.
