Overview

This bill modifies child care provider record-keeping requirements under the child care assistance program (CCAP).

Summary

Section Description

1 Record-keeping requirement.

Amends § 119B.125, subd. 6. Specifies that attendance records that are not immediately made available to the county or commissioner upon request are not valid for purposes of establishing proof that a child was present during the time period in question. Allows a county or the commissioner to establish an overpayment claim in the system against a current or former provider if an attendance record is found to be insufficient to support the information submitted on a billing form.
