Overview

Repeals the special law providing for a community corrections department in Ramsey County.

The earliest version of this law was enacted in 1923 and was last substantively amended in the 1980s. It provides for a department with a director appointed by a Corrections Management Committee comprised of three judges of the Second Judicial District and three members of the Ramsey County board. Duties of the department include those related to supervision of persons on probation, investigation, mental and physical services for diagnosis as ordered by the court, collection of support, custody matters, and other functions.
