Overview

This bill removes the requirement for health care and social services professionals (who are mandated reporters of suspected child maltreatment) to report a woman's use of a controlled substance for a nonmedical purpose or excessive consumption of alcohol during pregnancy to the local welfare agency, if the professional is providing the woman with prenatal care or other health care services.
