## **Overview**

This bill aligns the salaries of the assistant chief administrative law judge and the administrative law judge supervisors in the Office of Administrative Hearings to the salary of a district court judge.

Salaries for various administrative law judge roles are currently tied in law to a percentage of the salary of a comparable role for a district court judge. Currently, the assistant chief administrative law judge and administrative law judge supervisors earn 93.6 percent of the salary of a chief district court judge.

Based on salaries in effect July 1, 2018, the net effect of this bill would be to increase the salary of the assistant chief administrative law judge and administrative law judge supervisors from roughly \$154,475 to \$157,178.

The salary of other judges in the Office of Administrative Hearings would remain unchanged.
